3. **Financial report:** Allan Moses
 - Donations up this year \$1000 last year \$175

 - Sports Banquets: \$1950 budgeted
 - Restricted funds: need to reallocate some funds and disburse gymnastic team (no longer) money to all teams

- Golf Tournament: Date August 10 or 11—Jim will check so we don't conflict with Concord Memorial Hospital tournament

- We need to find new Golf chairman: Sandy & Steve Masters indicated that they would be willing take this on!!! Possibly Steve & Lois Davis would be good assistance

6. NEW BUSINESS
