- ❖ **New Requests**
 - Request from Hockey Team for \$1560 for equipment bags consisting of 24 bags at \$65 each with a life expectancy of 4-5 years.
 - Request from Tracy Berube for \$75 for Lindsay Bucknam's expenses to participate in Twin State Field Hockey Team. Motion was made by Suzie and seconded by Kristen to approve request and unanimously approved.
 - Request for Girls JV and Varsity Basketball for 2nd set of practice gear for each girl consisting of reversible and shorts, total request \$975 with a life expectancy on sets of 3-4 years.
- ❖ **Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes**
 - Minutes were reviewed from the last meeting. Lindsay made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, Suzie seconded and the minutes were unanimously approved.
- ❖ **Treasurer's Report**
 - Revenues: \$1,426.16 most of which was from concessions
 - Expense: One expense \$114 for pizza for concession stand

 - Motion was made to accept Treasurer's Report by Blaine and seconded by Steve. Treasurer's report unanimously approved.
- ❖ **Topics Discussed**

Bob will be completing a draft to send out to committee members before the end of the month. We also will be adding an option for students to complete the application on the computer. We will be meeting again and finalizing the application to present to the Board with a target of January meeting for presentation.

 - **Golf Tournament Committee:** Steve will be organizing this committee after January 1.

She will be moving the contents to the school for the basketball stand on Saturday 11/20 at 10 AM if any one can help please be there. Basketball concession stand will be starting in December.
